In these days children are already being raised socially and emotionally aware.


They are aware of what is happening around and the issues on their environment.

- I chose the topic of stray animals because there are lots of stray animals around our school area so students were aware of the topic.





- I asked students to share their feelings about the stray animals.

- Students to took a video and shared them on social media to get more attention on the issue and reach out more people.






- Encourage students to come up with ideas to collect donations to help the strain animals.

- Also we shared them on social media to reach out more people.
















 For instance; with the donations our students collected, we have fed lots of stray animals and covered a couple of serious surgeries.










- I found organizations that help stray animals.
